



Expectations for Live Learning Sessions

These rules are designed to keep everyone safe and able to learn.

- You must be appropriately dressed for live learning sessions (e.g. not wearing your pyjamas)

- Blur your background or put on an effect. 

- Turn your camera off until you are told to turn it on by a teacher.  (off)  (on)

- Turn your microphone off unless you are told to turn it on by a teacher.  (on)  (off)

- If you want to ask a question, raise your hand on Teams.  (hand up)  (hand down)

- You can turn your microphone on to ask or answer a question but you must turn it off again.  (on)  (off)


- Follow the school rules during the lesson

- You can only use the chat function to respond to questions or ask questions. 

- If you are using the chat function you must do so appropriately and with respect.

- The chat function must only be used to communicate with the teacher on topics related to the lesson.

- You must not take images of other students or staff. 

- You must not deliberately browse, download, upload or forward material that could be considered offensive. If you come across any material of this type you must tell your teacher or the school immediately.
- If you are not following the expectations of behaviour you will be given a warning. If the behaviour continues you may be removed from the session. 
- Parents will be contacted if children are not following our expectations or are displaying inappropriate behaviour during live learning sessions.
